Animal Care Experience **June 21 - 25** **July 19 - 23**

June Camp: Ages 6 - 8
July Camp: Ages 9 - 11
Delightful Dogs: 9 am - 12:30 pm

COST: \$70/child for a week of half days or \$125 for a week of full days

Get trained and ready to put those skills to work! All graduates of the Animal Academy gain a one-year membership to our Junior Volunteer Club. This club meets twice a month and gives kids an opportunity to volunteer without having a parent present. Cost includes an Animal Academy T-shirt, a Humane Society volunteer T-shirt, name tag and training materials.

Animal Advocate Camp **Aug. 16 - 20**

DETAILS:

9 am - 5 pm: Ages 10 - 14

COST: \$125/child

Animal Advocate Camp is for kids who have been through prior Humane Society summer camp sessions. Kids will further their animal skills while learning to protect and care for animals in our community and beyond.

Animal Adventure Days

DETAILS:

9 am - 3:30 pm Ages 13 - 18

COST: \$25/session

These one day seminars offer teens the chance to participate in specialized sessions in topics such as animal training and behavior and veterinary medicine. At the Animal Behavior and Training Seminar teens will have the chance to work with and train shelter dogs and cats as well as learn about common behavior problems and how to solve them. At the Veterinary Medicine Seminar, teens will get an exclusive look at what the veterinarian at HSKC does, including watching surgeries and vaccinations. **Class size is limited to 15 students/session.**
